

Sticker Design Contest

The City of Meridian invites Meridian residents to enter original artwork depicting themes related to the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Selected artwork may be digitized, printed on vinyl stickers, and distributed at promotional and outreach events.

Artwork created for entry in each category must depict the following themes:

- Pre-K (age 5 & under): What makes you feel happy and safe at home?
- Kids (ages 6-12): What makes home a fun and welcoming place?
- Teens (ages 13-17): How do friends, family, and community bring people together?
- Adults (ages 18 & up): How do homes, neighborhoods, and public spaces create belonging?

To enter the contest, submit original artwork with a completed, signed submission form, **by noon on Friday, April 11, 2025.** Contestants submitting artwork on paper must submit the artwork and a completed, signed submission form to the Community Development Department, located on the first floor of Meridian City Hall, 33 E. Broadway Avenue, in Meridian, Idaho, during business hours. To submit a digital version, upload your artwork and submit the form at: https://meridiancity.org/announcements. Digital files must be at least 300 DPI and can be submitted in PDF, SVG, JPEG, or PNG format (max file size: 10MB).

All artwork submitted must be two-dimensional and must be on a 3" circle or a 3"x3" square/diamond. A template with the correct sizes is below or available online at https://meridiancity.org/announcements.

All entries must be received by noon on April 11, 2025. Up to three (3) entries per person will be considered. A selection committee will review all complete submissions received and select the artwork in each category that, in the committee's sole discretion, best depicts the above themes. Winners will be notified by April 18, 2025 and recognized at the April 22, 2025 Meridian City Council meeting. Late or incomplete entries will not be considered. City of Meridian employees and their household members are not eligible to enter this contest. The City reserves the right to cancel this contest at any time for any reason.
